Packets will be available beginning Friday, February 1. Drop off completed logs and pick up additional logs in this same location until Friday, April 26. The FOUCL May newsletter will include the top participant-recommended book titles along with names of the 3 people recording the most pages of completed titles.

In conjunction with the Winter Read Challenge, FOUCL is sponsoring 3 FREE programs in the library's Community Room during February, March, and April. Everyone in our community and surrounding area is invited to attend.

**Classic Book Trivia Contest** is on Wednesday, March 20 beginning at 2:00 PM (create teams of 4 or come and be randomly paired with others to create a 4-person team)

**Movie at the Library** is on Thursday, April 25 at 4:30 PM (join us to watch a book-based movie while eating some delicious popcorn)
